Judge Green began her career as an Assistant U.S. Attorney in the Civil Division of the U.S. Attorney's Office for the District of Massachusetts. She was subsequently appointed First Assistant U.S. Attorney, overseeing the civil and criminal litigation of approximately ninety assistant U.S. attorneys, stepping in as Acting U.S. Attorney when required, and directing the office's health care fraud enforcement. Between those chapters, she served as Chief of Staff to Governor William F. Weld. In private practice, Judge Green chaired the litigation department at Hale and Dorr and later co-chaired it at WilmerHale, while defending companies and their executives in high-stakes business litigation, government investigations, and False Claims Act matters, mostly in federal courts. She took the bench of the Massachusetts Superior Court in 2016, presiding over criminal and civil cases, including in the Business Litigation Session reserved for the state's most complex commercial disputes.

After leaving the bench, she established her own firm, Green Law LLC, where she has resolved business disputes through mediation and arbitrated as a member of the American Arbitration Association's Roster of Commercial Arbitrators and National Judicial Payor-Provider Panel.

"Attorneys will find in Judge Green a neutral who understands their case from every angle and knows exactly what it takes to resolve it," said Dario Higuchi, founder and Chief Executive Officer of Signature Resolution. "We are proud to welcome her to our panel."

Judge Green has earned wide recognition in the profession, including honors from Chambers USA, The Best Lawyers in America, and the Women's White Collar Defense Association, which named her a Trailblazer. She served as President of the Litigation Counsel of America, co-chairs the Rule of Law Leadership Council of the World Justice Project, and will share some of her learnings with a new generation of lawyers as a Lecturer on Law at Harvard Law School come spring.
