

Former Entertainment Biz Exec Joins Signature Resolution

Law360 (June 16, 2026, 4:03 PM EDT) -- Alternative dispute resolution firm Signature Resolution has picked up a Los Angeles-based former entertainment industry executive with experience at NBCUniversal and Miramax as a mediator.

David Shraga brings his studio experience, as well as experience as a litigator from earlier in his career, to Signature Resolution, the firm announced on Monday.

He told Law360 Pulse the move is a "natural evolution" of his professional path up to this point.

"I feel privileged being at this point in my career, having this diverse experience, to be able to step into this role and to work with a place like Signature and the excellent neutrals who are there, and to really be of service to the community of lawyers and clients that we interact with," Shraga said.

Shraga has been working on his own as a mediator over the past year, but said joining Signature Resolution gives him access to better resources to reach resolutions for his clients, including scheduling and technology services.

A Yale University and University of Southern California School of Law graduate, Shraga began his career as a litigator at Alschuler Grossman Stein & Kahan LLP before launching his own litigation boutique of KSW LLP in Los Angeles, which he ran as managing partner from 2008 to 2015.

In what he described as the "second half" of his career, Shraga took on in-house roles as a dealmaker within the studio system. He progressed through several legal and business affairs at NBCUniversal in television and theatrical matters, culminating in working as vice president for international television business affairs for Universal International Studios from 2019 to 2022.

Shraga went on to work as senior vice president and head of global television business and legal affairs for Miramax from 2022 to 2025 before switching to alternative dispute resolution work.

Shraga said the work of dealmaking from within the studio system and in mediation calls for a similar skill set and a similar philosophy of guiding the parties to an agreement that serves their interests.

"What you're doing is you're just, from my perspective, making a deal at a different stage in the

process," Shraga said.

While his experience most recently has been in media and entertainment, Shraga said he's looking forward to taking on a wide range of matters in his new role. He gained significant experience in areas like employment law while in-house and in civil litigation and real estate in private practice, all of which will come to bear on his mediation work.

"This role is the combination of all the different things that I've done over the years," Shraga said.

Dario Higuchi, founder and CEO of Signature Resolution, said in a statement on Monday that Shraga "knows the entertainment industry from the inside, and that knowledge gives him a rare ability to meet every party in a complex dispute exactly where they are."

"We are proud to welcome him to our panel," Higuchi said.
